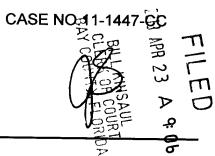

AMENDED FINAL JUDGMENT OF FORECLOSURE

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on the Plaintiff's Complaint for the foreclosure of a lien against the real property of the Defendant, First Baptist Church of Panama City Beach, Inc. A trial in this matter was held on October 2, 2012, and the Court reviewed the pleadings on file, heard argument of counsel, heard testimony of the parties and witnesses, received exhibits, and having been otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is hereby

ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:

1. Plaintiff, Landmark General Contractors, Inc., is due the following:

which shall bear interest at the current statutory rate of four and three-quarters percent (4.75%).

2. Plaintiff holds a lien for the total sum on the Defendant's real property in Bay County, Florida, and more particularly described on "Exhibit A."

- 3. If the total sum with interest at the rate described in Paragraph 1 and all costs accrued subsequent to this judgment is not paid, the Clerk of this Court shall sell the property at a public sale on May 28, 2013, to the highest bidder for cash, except as hereinafter set forth, at the Bay County Courthouse, 300 East 4th Street, in Panama City, Bay County, Florida, in accordance with Florida Statutes § 45.031, using the following method: electronic sale beginning at 11:00 a.m. on the prescribed date at www.bay.realforeclose.com.
- 4. Plaintiff shall advance all subsequent costs of this action and shall be reimbursed for them by the Clerk if Plaintiff is not the purchaser of the property for sale, provided, however, that the purchaser of the property for sale shall be responsible for the documentary stamps payable on the certificate of title. If Plaintiff is the purchaser, the Clerk shall credit Plaintiff's bid with the total sum with interest and costs accruing subsequent to this judgment, or such part of it as is necessary to pay the bid in full.
- 5. On filing the Certificate of Title, the Clerk shall distribute the proceeds of the sale, so far as they are sufficient, by paying: first, all of Plaintiff's costs; second, documentary stamps affixed to the Certificate; third, Plaintiff's attorney fees; fourth, the total sum due to Plaintiff, less the items paid, plus interest at the rate prescribed in Paragraph 1 from this date to the date of the sale, and by retaining any remaining amount pending further Order of this Court.
- 6. On filing the Certificate of Sale, the Defendant and all persons under or against the Defendant since the filing of the Notice of Lis Pendens shall be foreclosed of all estate or claim in the property, except as to claims or rights under chapter 718 or chapter 720, Florida Statutes, if any. Upon the filing of the Certificate of Title, the person

named on the Certificate of Title shall be let into possession of the property. If the Defendant remains in possession of the property, the Clerk, without further Order of the Court, will issue forthwith a writ of possession upon written request of the person named on the Certificate of Title.

7. Jurisdiction in this action is retained to enter further Orders that are proper, including, without limitation, a deficiency judgment and writ of possession.

IF THIS PROPERTY IS SOLD AT PUBLIC AUCTION, THERE MAY BE ADDITIONAL MONEY FROM THE SALE AFTER PAYMENT OF PERSONS WHO ARE ENTITLED TO BE PAID FROM THE SALE PROCEEDS PURSUANT TO THIS FINAL JUDGMENT.

IF YOU ARE A SUBORDINATE LIENHOLDER CLAIMING A RIGHT TO FUNDS REMAINING AFTER THE SALE, YOU MUST FILE A CLAIM WITH THE CLERK NO LATER THAN 60 DAYS AFTER THE SALE; IF YOU FAIL TO FILE A CLAIM, YOU WILL NOT BE ENTITLED TO ANY REMAINING FUNDS.
