

- 4. <u>Costs.</u> Plaintiff shall advance all subsequent costs of this action and shall be reimbursed for them by the clerk if Plaintiff is not the purchaser of the property for sale, provided, however, that the purchaser of the property for sale shall be responsible for the documentary stamps payable on the certificate of title. If Plaintiff is the purchaser, the clerk shall credit Plaintiff's bid with the total sum with interest and costs accruing subsequent to this judgment, or such part of it, as is necessary to pay the bid in full.
- 5. <u>Distribution of Proceeds.</u> On filing the certificate of title the clerk shall distribute the proceeds of the sale, so far as they are sufficient, by paying: first, all of Plaintiff's costs; second, documentary stamps affixed to the certificate; third, Plaintiff's attorneys' fees; fourth, the total sum due to Plaintiff, less the items paid, plus interest at the rate prescribed in paragraph 1 from this date to the date of the sale; and by retaining any remaining amount pending the further order of this Court.

- 6. Right of Redemption/Right of Possession. On filing the certificate of sale, the Defendants and all persons claiming under or against Defendants since the filing of the Notice of Lis Pendens shall be foreclosed of all estate or claim in the property and Defendants' right of redemption as prescribed by section 45.0315, Florida Statutes (2013), shall be terminated, except as to claims or rights under Chapter 718 or Chapter 720, Florida Statutes, if any. Upon the filing of the certificate of title, the person named on the certificate of title shall be let into possession of the property.
- 7. <u>Attorney's Fees.</u> The Plaintiff did not seek an award of attorney's fees and costs in this matter.
- 8. <u>Jurisdiction Retained.</u> Jurisdiction of this action is retained to enter further orders that are proper including, without limitation, writs of possession and deficiency judgment.¹
